

Being Brilliant in Grade 12 Physics!

In physics class we have been analyzing the momentum and forces involved in a car collision. Given the result of the crash, and measuring where the cars ended up, we were able to work backwards to determine the speeds of the cars. It turns out, the Right Honourable Messrs. Turner and Bennett were both speeding! When we look at the distance that the cars slid after colliding, we can use the principle of conservation of momentum to calculate that both drivers were travelling between 48 and 60 km/h.
