Governor General's Academic Medal

The Governor General's Academic Medal was first awarded in 1873 by the Earl of Dufferin, and has since become one of the most prestigious awards that a student in a Canadian educational institution can receive. The Governor General of Canada continues this tradition of encouraging scholarship across the nation and recognizing outstanding students.

The Bronze award is granted at the Secondary level, with silver going to undergraduate postsecondary students and the gold award to graduate postsecondary students.

The bronze medal is awarded to the student who achieves the highest average upon graduation from a secondary school. This year's winner of the Governor General's Academic Medal is **Victoria M!**
