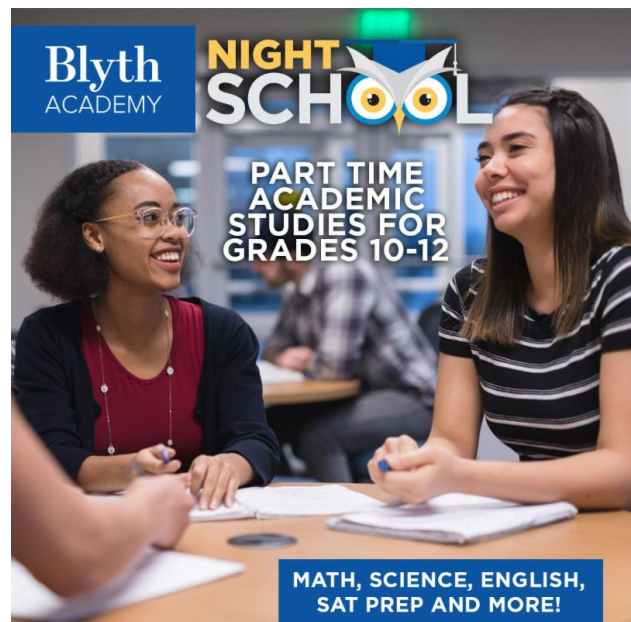
The Ontario University Fair is here! All grade 12 students went to the Metro Convention Centre on this morning.
