Period 2: 9:30am - 10:15am

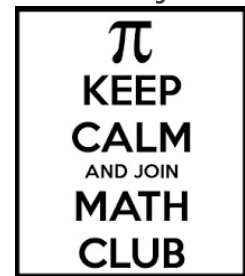
Period 3: 10:15am - 11am

Through the Junior Achievement's Entrepreneurship in the Classroom program, the grade 11 Entrepreneurship class had a visit from marketing consultant Maureen McCabe who guided the class through a lesson in maximising exposure through online marketing.





Creative Destruction Lab (CDL) is within the University of Toronto's Rotman School of Management. CDL is a program for early-stage massively scalable, science-based start-ups. Since its launch in 2012, over 1,000 founders representing more than 500 companies have participated in the program. The successful commercialization of cutting-edge science achieved through the program has led to the creation of over \$3 billion in equity value.

They are calling for applications for Session #2's High Schools Girl Program which invites female high-school students who are ambitious and curious to learn more about entrepreneurship, technology, and/or science-based innovation. Students will have the opportunity to meet and observe a series of small group meetings with early-stage start-ups followed by an afternoon of a large group discussion that focuses on identifying technical/business milestones to achieve by the next session. In addition, each student will be assigned to a CDL Fellow or Associate (individuals who mentor CDL companies - this [list](#) includes Col. Chris Hadfield, the founders of WIND Mobile, KIK, and Kobo) and will become their shadow for the day.

Our own **Arwen Kaposi** attended Session 1 in October and had an exciting and instructive day.

There are four session dates left in our program each with forty seats reserved for students:

- December 12-13, 2018
- February 20-21, 2018
- May 1-2, 2018
- June 12-13, 2018

If students are unavailable to participate for the upcoming session there will be three other opportunities during the year in which they can select to be considered for.
